

# REMINDER: Your Account



- Click on the drop down that reads "My Account"
- Once in your account you can access your profiles
  - Update Contact Information
  - Review your participants and their evaluations or achievements
  - THE CALENDAR TAB while logged into your account shows all your registered skating times and events.
  - Invoice Tab for copies of all your registrations



- The club will need to confirm addresses of those that qualify for the city subsidy.
- The subsidy covers the balance set program cost
- Paying a subsidy non-qualifier fee
  - This amount is the same amount as what the city pays for those within their city limits
  - Where to address concerns

#### Intermediates

- 50% group lesson time
- Share the ice with Seniors (all levels on Saturdays)
- New to Intermediates? Arranging Private Lessons is recommended
  - Focused needs of your skater, creation of freeskate solo's for competition and development, for coaching assessment through Star 5

#### Seniors


- 15 min Group Lesson Time Daily
- Partially Shared Ice with Intermediates (all levels on Saturdays)



### Synchro

- All STARSkaters are encouraged to take part in Synchro
- As part of the Skate Canada curriculum, this session is an excellent opportunity to develop skating skills in a fun and supportive atmosphere.
- Or keep up your skating skills in a team environment
- Our goal is to have two teams this season to welcome all level of Starskaters
- The cost is \$150 (\$25 installments/month) as an add-on to a fulltime Starskate Registration .
- Part-time Star/Synchro available on request
- Synchro includes ice time, coaching, off-ice classes, the Team portion of competition registration fees
  - New team members will also receive a free Sychro Jacket






- 2025 Fall Skate Invitational Cody Banks
