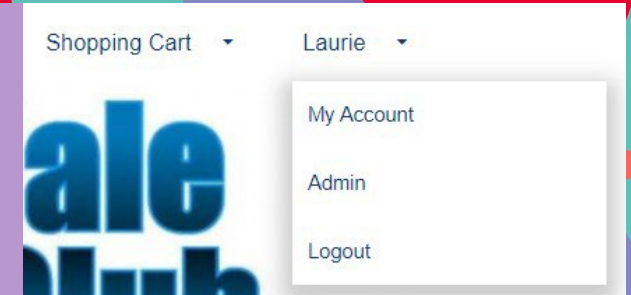

Your skaters are currently on the Starskate Pathway in the learn-to-train level as part of the Sport for Life's Long-term development

When logged into your account with Skate Canada you can read more on the Starskate Pathway

Go to skatecanada.ca/members to create an account in your child's name. This way you will be able to see their STARskate Achievements and follow their official progress.

REMINDER: Your Account



- Click on the drop down that reads “My Account”
- Once in your account you can access your profiles
 - Update Contact Information
 - Review your participants and their evaluations or achievements
 - THE CALENDAR TAB while logged into your account shows all your registered skating times and events.
 - Invoice Tab for copies of all your registrations

City Subsidy

- The club will need to confirm addresses of those that qualify for the city subsidy.
- The subsidy covers the balance set program cost
- Paying a subsidy non-qualifier fee
 - This amount is the same amount as what the city pays for those within their city limits

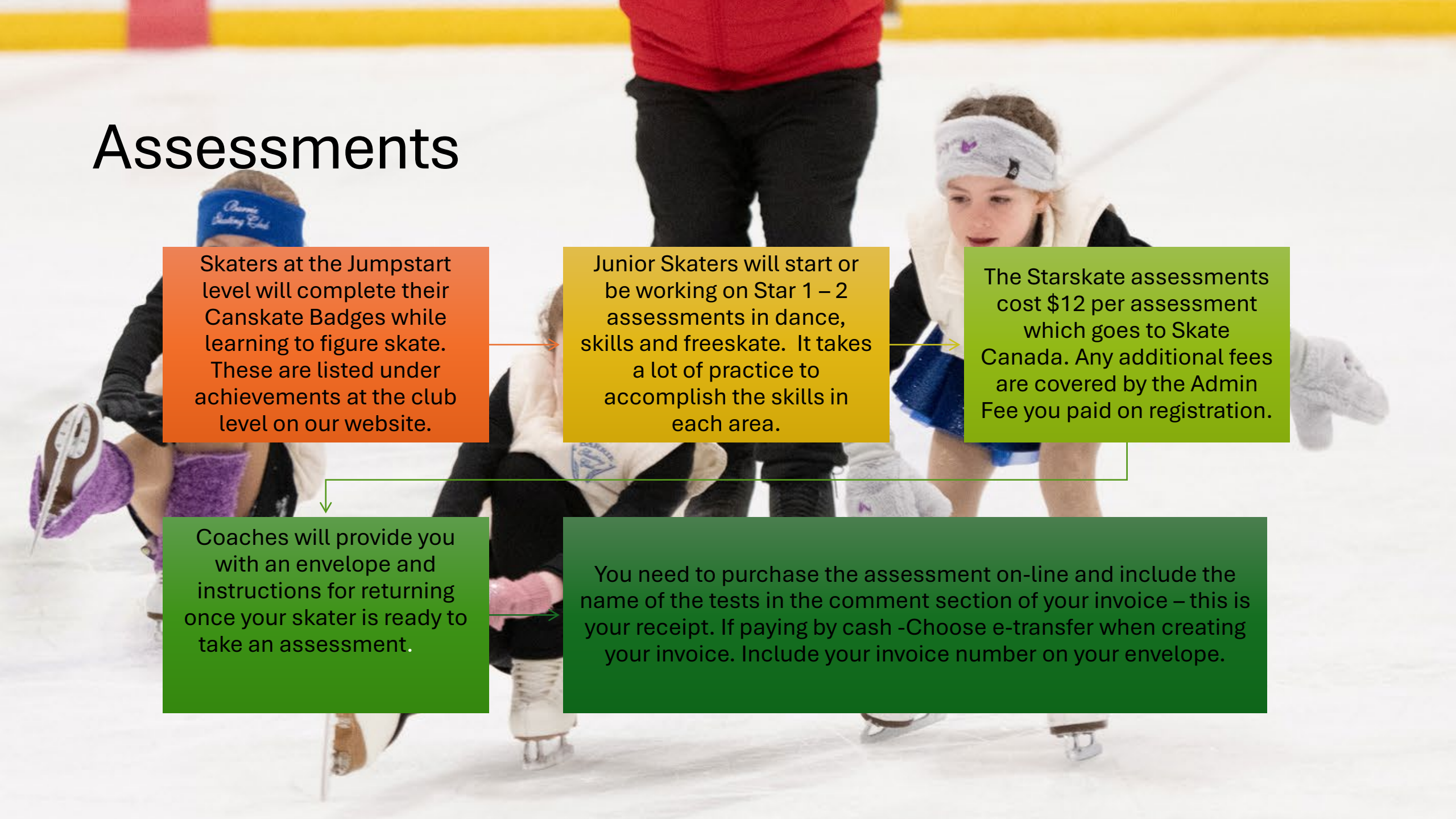

Program Specifics

- Jumpstart
 - Fast Track to figure skating
 - 100% group lesson time
 - Share the ice with Juniors
- Juniors
 - Star 1 & 2 levels or with coach recommendation
 - $\frac{3}{4}$ of the time is Group Lesson Time
 - $\frac{1}{4}$ is self practice with supervision; important part of development
 - Shared Ice with either Jumpstart or Intermediate/Seniors
- Private Lesson Options

Assessments



Skaters at the Jumpstart level will complete their Canskate Badges while learning to figure skate. These are listed under achievements at the club level on our website.

Junior Skaters will start or be working on Star 1 – 2 assessments in dance, skills and freeskate. It takes a lot of practice to accomplish the skills in each area.

The Starskate assessments cost \$12 per assessment which goes to Skate Canada. Any additional fees are covered by the Admin Fee you paid on registration.

Coaches will provide you with an envelope and instructions for returning once your skater is ready to take an assessment.

You need to purchase the assessment on-line and include the name of the tests in the comment section of your invoice – this is your receipt. If paying by cash -Choose e-transfer when creating your invoice. Include your invoice number on your envelope.

Synchro

- All STARSkaters are encouraged to take part in Synchro
- As part of the Skate Canada curriculum, this session is an excellent opportunity to develop skating skills in a fun and supportive atmosphere.
- For the skaters, this is a great opportunity to engage in a team environment which complements personal skills learned as a singles figure skater.
- The cost is \$150 (\$25 installments/month) as an add-on to a Starskate Registration .
- Synchro includes ice time, coaching, off-ice classes, the Team portion of competition registration fees
 - New team members will also receive a free Sychro Jacket



Events

JUMPSTARTS

- Can register for our club “Canskate Merit Event”
- As part of Skate Canada’s long-term-development, these type of events get your skater ready for the learn-to-train at the Junior level.
- Take advantage of any performance opportunity like our Holiday Performance Food Bank Drive
- If your skater moves up to Junior, they will have other opportunities as well.
- Join the Synchro Session on Sundays. As your skater does not have a regular jumpstart session this day, this will give them the opportunity to work and develop their skating skills while having fun learning on a team. More on synchro later.....

Events

JUNIORS

- We encourage all skaters at this level to participate in appropriate level events that are offered to further their development and prepares the skater for choosing skating pathways
- They may not know at this time if they want to be a podium pathway skater and try out for Canada Games or Nationals. Preparing leaves these options open.
- Events this season:
 - 2025 Fall Skate Invitational – Cody Banks Arena – Registration opens Oct 18 – 25 STAR 1 – 4 Events
 - 2026 ADL Starskate Competition – Event is Feb 14, 2025
 - Synchro Events also on island are the Friendship Competition in January & Maritime Championships March 1st
 - Skaters may also go to off-island events. There are opportunities close by in NB & NS. SPSC offers funding of \$100 for one off-island event

Competition Hosts

- Sherwood Parkdale Skating Club is part of the Island Skating Academy for programs in the off-season.
- We will be hosting the 2025 PEI Fall INVITATIONAL. Volunteers will be needed at the event on Saturday, November 15th or set up on November 14th
 - Announcer – not limited to bilingual but would be great if you speak both English & French
 - Announcer back up/shadow
 - Videographer - everything is pre-set up, just follow the skater. No experience necessary
 - Ice Captains, Registration Desk, Sales

- No make-up or refunds for personal reasons ie holidays etc

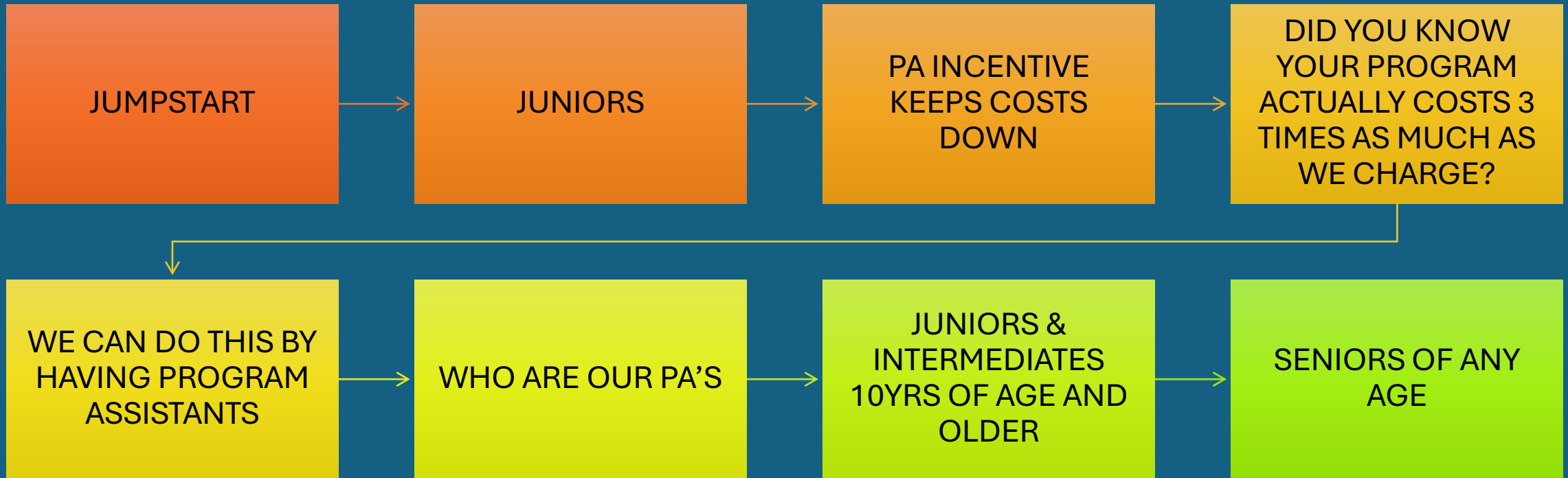
PA Incentive under Volunteers

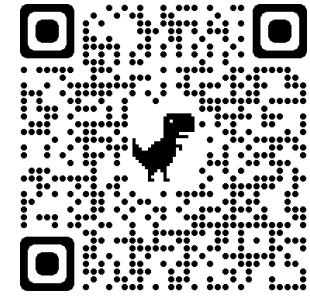
