



Hello Skaters and Families,

Happy New Year! You are receiving this e-mail as you have a participant(s) registered in one of our Winter Part 2 Canskate Programs. We want to welcome you (or welcome you back) to Sherwood Parkdale Skating Club and provide you with some reminders and information before we step on the ice this coming week.

## A MUST READ - WHAT TO BRING:

- Skates (we do not rent skates). Don't forget to sharpen your skates! New skates also need to be sharpened.
- Skate Guards – required on all non rubber surfaces in the facility. You also do not want to ruin your blades and nice new sharpening! A must have if you are arriving with skates on and walking in the parking lot. SPSC has a limited supply available for sale.
- **CSA approved hockey style helmet is mandatory**, and skaters will not be permitted on the ice without one (due to insurance purposes & their safety). Ski, Bike, universal helmets are NOT allowed. A face guard is recommended for Beginner Skaters.
- It can be quite cool inside the rink. Rather than wearing a snow suit though, we recommend dressing in layers. Snow suits tend to be too bulky and can be difficult to move in. **Mittens or Gloves are mandatory**.
- If you are new to Sherwood Parkdale Skating Club AND have skated in a Canskate program at another club, please bring your last report card with you. You may also e-mail report cards ahead of time to [office@sherwoodparkdaleskatingclub.com](mailto:office@sherwoodparkdaleskatingclub.com) for coaching review.
- Review our Canskate Information on our home page for items like “how to find my report card, my calendar of skating times, events, and more....”

The first day may be hectic. Arrive early so that you and your skater can be relaxed and prepared before the session begins. Once you arrive, there will be a table where you will check in. Each time you arrive you will collect your skater's name tag and check their name off a list indicating they are present. Check the notice board for your dressing room assignment. Please avoid using the stands to tie skates as there is insufficient protective coverage on the cement floors to protect your skates. When you are ready, skaters may line up against the boards by the ice surface to wait for instruction.

A short Parent Meeting will take place upstairs in the viewing area on your first day. After the meeting (or on the other session days), we realize you want the best view of your child as they skate. Please remain in the warm viewing area upstairs, the bleachers, or at the boards in front of the dressing rooms (though please do not block the doors). No parents are permitted on the bench (opposite the bleachers, near the time box). ***This is for Coaches and Program Assistants only and is not a viewing area.***

## NEW THIS SEASON


The City of Charlottetown is requiring we confirm addresses for those that qualify for their city subsidy. Please bring with you (or be able to pull up on your phone) something that shows your home address on your first day of skating. We will review and mark confirmed on our participant list after the parent meeting. By confirming your address this will aid the City in paying out the funding without any holdups or denials. This subsidy covers the full cost of your program. Those of us outside the city limits pay this portion of the full registration fee.

**NOTE:** *Only* parents/guardians who are *registered members of Skate Canada in our Parent Assisted Canskate Program* or *a registered Program Assistant with permission*, may go on the ice to assist skaters. Registered Parents must wear a CSA approved hockey style helmet unless assessed for the appropriate skill level by our Club Coaches. Our Certified Professional Coaches and Program Assistants will open the doors for you and help your participant onto the ice.

**Parent Assisted Canskate Info:** *Only* one parent assistant may go on the ice with each participant each session. If you registered two assistants (for one skater), you would share days you go on the ice with your participant. Parent memberships are not transferable.

If at any time you would like to speak with a coach, please do so at the end of our session once their instructional time is over. They will be happy to speak with you.
