



Your Account



- Click on the drop down that reads "My Account"
- Once in your account you can access your profiles
 - Update Contact Information
 - Review your participants and their evaluations or achievements
 - THE CALENDAR TAB while logged into your account shows all your registered skating times and events.
 - Invoice Tab for copies of all your registrations



- The club will need to confirm addresses of those that qualify for the city subsidy.
- The subsidy covers the balance of the full program cost
- Paying a subsidy non-qualifier fee
 - This amount is the same amount as what the city pays for those within their city limits
 - Where to address concerns



STORM WATCHES AND CLOSURES – in the event of storms or unforeseen closures, we will post on our website as well as send you an email. We normally only close if the facility is closed. Therefor if you see from a community posting that the arena is closed, then so are we. There is the off-chance if our administrator does not have power, they will not be able to email you. Please don't call the arena as they are not part of our operation for detailed info.

Program Specifics

- Your skaters name tag will have a colour indicating their group
 - This colour does NOT reflect what stage of canskate achievement they have
 - The groupings on the ice are to maintain coach ratio and put children together that are either at the same level or working on similar skills.
 - Skaters may get moved from time-to-time to another group for best practice
 - If they skate more than one day a week, they may have a different colour group on each day dependant on the balance of skaters on the ice for that day.
 - No matter which group a skater is in, they will ALWAYS work at their personal level.

PRIVATE LESSONS

Option for skaters registered in a group program based on availability.

Canskate: private lessons may be arranged with the coach of your choosing as available. Lessons from our *Group Canskate Coaches* would need to take place during another session time. You can be on a non-canskate session for the length of your lesson only. You may also contact *non-Canskate Group Coaches* to have private lesson time during Canskate Sessions *space permitting*. Private lessons are based on availability of coaches and all payment arrangements are between you and the coach.
