Your Account



- Click on the drop down that reads My Account
- Once in your account you can access your profiles
 - Update contact information
 - Review your participants and their evaluations or achievements
 - THE CALENDAR tab while logged into your account shows all your registered skating times and events.
 - Invoice tab for copies of all your registrations

- SPSC runs the updated approved Skate Canada Powerskate Program.
- There are varied levels of skaters on the session
 - Early Stage of Development
 - Moderate Stage of Development
 - Advanced Stage of Development
- Skaters will work in a group format on varied skills with different targeted expectations to achieve the quality required at their stage of development.
- Dryland off-ice session included in your registration is to further enhance the development of the athlete

- There will be up to three professional NCCP certified coaches on the ice.
